Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) combines medicine and therapy to treat substance use disorders. The medications used are prescriptions such as Suboxone. The doctor and your therapist will make sure you get the right treatment and support. MAT does not substitute one drug for another. Instead, the medicines relieve withdrawal symptoms and cravings. MAT programs provide a safe and controlled level of medicine to overcome opioid abuse. Research has shown that these medicines have no adverse effects on the person's mental and physical health, or the ability to work. People may use MATs for months, years or the rest of their lives. Plans to stop taking the medicine should be discussed with your doctor.
