Disciplinary Actions

The Network Operations Credentialing staff conducts monthly reviews of the following U.S. Department of Health & Human Services entities for disciplinary actions.

- Office of Inspector General (OIG)
- System for Award Management (SAM)
- National Plan & Provider Enumeration System (NPPES)
- National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB)
- National Technical Information Services (NTIS)



Social Security Administration (SSA)

Information from the SSA Death Master File (SSA DMF) is compared to the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) on a monthly basis by the Sandhills Center Credentialing staff.

Insurance Monitoring

Monitoring is conducted based on the expiration date with the provider being notified 30 days prior to expiration and requested to submit an updated certificate.

License Monitoring

- Conducted based on the expiration date with the provider being notified 30 days prior to expiration and requested to submit an updated license.
- Licensure sanctions and limitations are checked monthly by the Sandhills Center Credentialing staff.

Accreditation

For newly DMA enrolled providers, accreditation is based on a benchmark status determined by the provider's DMA enrollment date and then by a predetermined pattern as set by the NC General Statute for National Accreditation Benchmarks (122C-81). Providers have one year to achieve Accreditation.



Accreditation Renewal

Is monitored by Sandhills Center Credentialing staff with providers being advised 30 days prior to expiration to submit accreditation renewal documentation.
