

**Transition from the Current NC Innovation’s Service Array to
the Amended Innovations Waiver Service Array**

- The services in current approved Individual Support Plan (ISP) may continue until the implementation of the next annual (ISP) which goes into effect on the first of the month after the beneficiary’s birth month.
- The individual may choose to submit a revision to their ISP to change services at any time during the year. This includes adding services from the amendment once approved.
- No new authorizations for services that have been removed from the waiver will be authorized after the waiver amendment goes into effect.
